

Safety Instruction



1. **Read Instructions** - All the safety and operating instructions should be read before the appliance is operated.

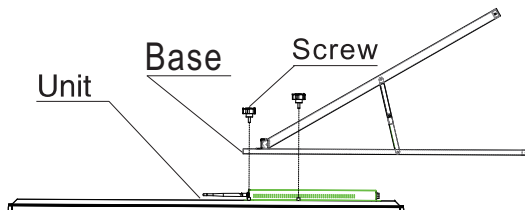

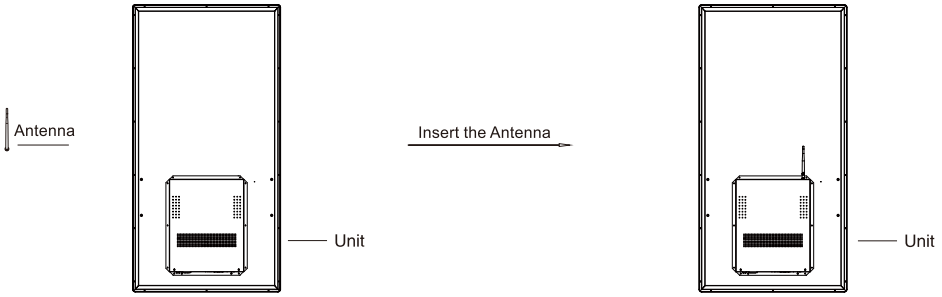

3. Remove the screw from the accessory bag and fasten the base to the machine according to the following instructions.

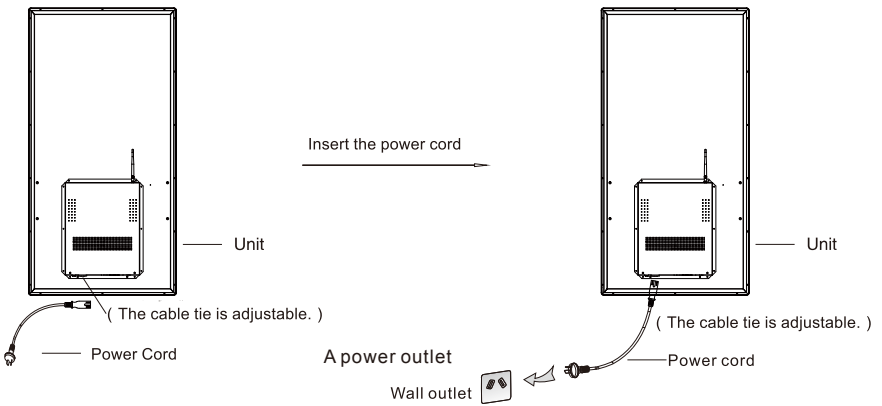


Antenna Assembly Diagram

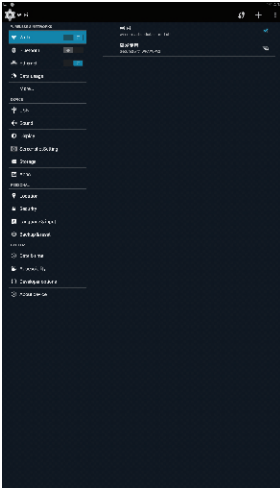


Connecting the Power Cord

According to the remote control ▼ ▲ ,

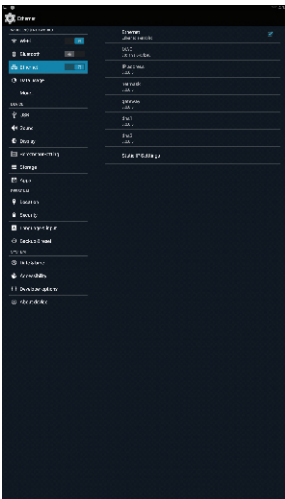
Select this item and press ► go to Settings.

4. Ethernet Settings



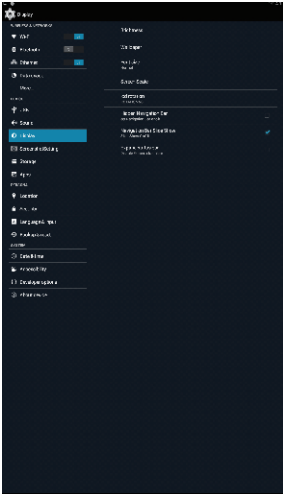
According to the remote control ▼ ▲ ,

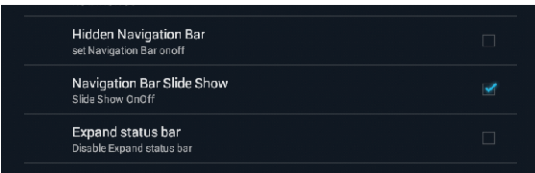
Note: Ethernet's C MAC address is the system's only permanently valid device ID.

 Select this item and press ► go to Settings.

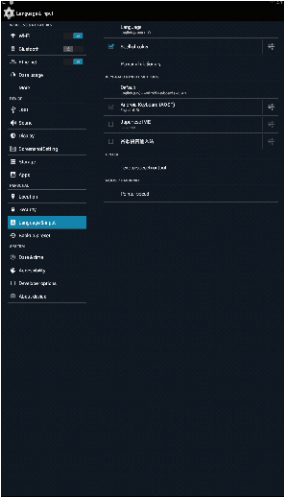
5.1 hidden status bar setting interface

6. Language Settings



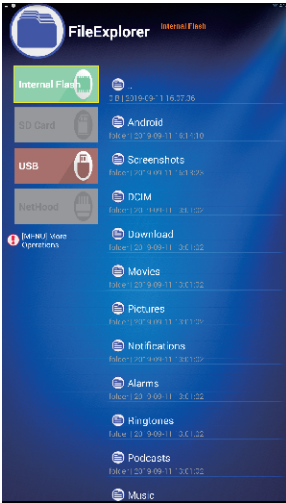

10. Analysis of common faults

1. The machine has a black screen and no backlight. Check whether the 220V voltage is normal and the power cord drawn by the machine is external Whether the connection of the power cord is connected.
2. If there is no sound after starting, check whether the volume is adjusted to the minimum and whether the mute switch is turned on.
3. The remote control does not work, check whether the battery of the remote control is installed or whether the battery is charged.
4. The machine time is not displayed correctly. Connect to the network and turn on the automatic network update time.
5. This advertising machine is an intelligent chip control device, except for the above problems, it still cannot be reconnected to the power Normal operation, please contact supplier or professional repairman.

Remote Control

Power button
Toggles the unit between standby and on.

MUTE button
Press to mute the sound. Press again or press VOL+/- to resume.

Numerical buttons
Press 0-9 to select a unit/channel directly when watching the unit display screen. The channel changes after 2 seconds or press "OK" button to change immediately.

MENU button
Press to display the main menu.
EXIT button
Exit most menu to default status directly. Press to quit all menu.
Navigation keys (▲/▼/◀/▶/OK)
Allows you to navigate the on screen menus and adjust the system settings to your preference.

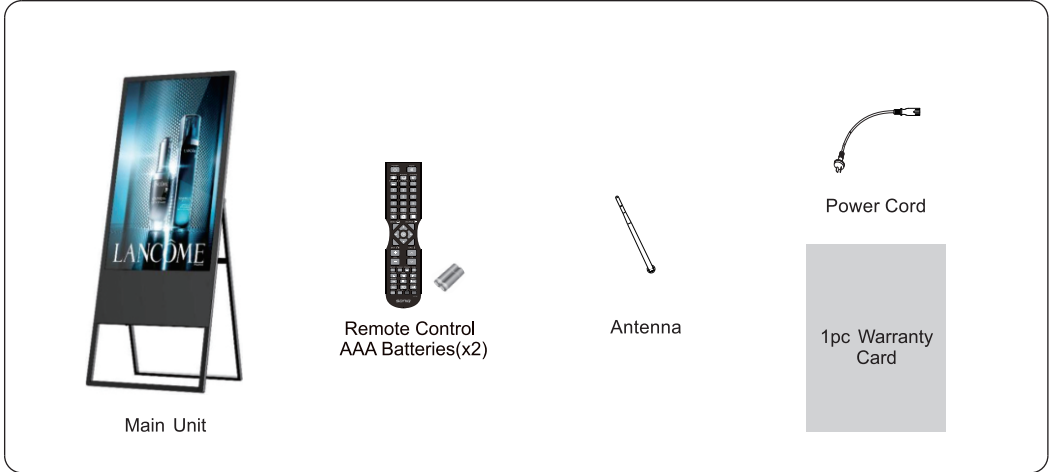
