Safety Instruction



- 1. Read Instructions All the safety and operating instructions should be read before the appliance is operated.
- 2. Retain Instructions The safety and operating instructions should be retained for future reference.
- 3. Heed Warnings All warnings on the appliance and in the operating instructions should be adhered to.
- 4. Follow Instructions All operating instructions should be followed.
- 5. Battery Batteries shall not be exposed to excessive heat such as sunshine, fire or the like.
- Earthing Connection The apparatus shall be connected to a MAINS socket outlet with a protective earthing connection.
- 7. Water and Moisture The appliance should not be used near water.
- 8. Ventilation The appliance should be well situated so that its location or position does not interfere with its proper ventilation.
- 9. Heat This appliance should be placed away from heat sources such as radiators, heat registersand stoves.
- **10. Power Sources -** The appliance should only be connected to a power supply as described in the operating instructions or as marked on the appliance.
- 11. Grounding or Polarization Precautions should be taken.
- **12.** Power Cord Protection Power supply cord should be located so that it is not likely to be walked on, or pinched by items placed upon it.

- 16. Conditions Requiring Service The appliance should be serviced by qualified service personnel when:


The power-supply cord or the plug has been damaged.

The appliance has been exposed to rain.


The appliance does not appear to operate normally or exhibits a marked change in performance.

- 20. Keep the key properly. There are high voltage and dangerous live parts inside. It's better to maintain and repair with a professional.





High voltages are used in the operation of this product. Do not remove the back cover of the cabinet. Refer servicing to qualified service personnel.




Warning

Do not insert foreign objects into the television's slots or openings. Never spill any kind of liquid on the television receiver.




Caution

Do not place the main unit on an unstable cart stand, shelf or table.


Serious injury to an individual, and damage to the television, may result should it fall.






Caution



Wall-mount Installation

- 1. Install the mount, as shown in figure(1). Make sure that the supporting surface will safely support the combined load of the equipment and all attached hardware and components.
- 2. Install the bracket, as shown in figure(2).
- 3. Place the TV with bracket on the mount, as shown in figure(3).

Highly recommend consult or ask the professionals to install!







Wall Mounting Instruction

This TV is equipped with mounting holes of 400x400mm.


If the thickness of the wall mount is 2mm, 4PCS of type M6 x 12mm screws are required (the length of the screws fixed in the interior of the TV should not be longer than 12mm).


Recommend to use SONIQ wall mount and install by professional people (do not operate while the TV is on).






Antenna Assembly Diagram





Connecting the Power Cord

Connect the power cord directly to the wall outlet.





Network Connection

It will prompt to connect to a network when you turn on the TV for the first time.

If there is no available network, press NEXT Button to exit. And press Home Button on the remote control to access Home Page.







DTV Tuning

Press Source Button on the remote control to select DTV Mode, and press OK Button to enter.

1. Auto Tuning

Press Menu Button on the remote control to access Channel Search, and to select Full Band Search.





2. Manual Tuning

Press Menu Button on the remote control to access Channel Search, and to select Manual Search.





Source Setting

1. Select available Source Input by pressing the SOURCE Button on the remote control.



2. Use ▲/▼ Buttons to select and press "OK" Button to confirm.




Logging in

Login with your provided Cybercast account information. That includes a username and password.




Device Manager

Then simply select your location and apply.


You have now assigned your digital display to your location.

Media Manager


This is where you will manage your media files, such as an image or video file.

This is where you will choose a template and attach media files to the template for your ads.


Start new campaign

Type in a name for your campaign in the field provided.




Then choose the template that best suits your advertisement.

Some templates can have sections allocated for videos or even scrolling text.


You can simply use the filter template options to find a suitable template.

Once saved, your campaign will be listed under **Campaign Manager**.




If you need to remove your campaign, click the bin icon to remove.




