- 1. Read Instructions All the safety and operating instructions should be read before the appliance is operated.
- 2. Retain Instructions The safety and operating instructions should be retained for future reference.

Best Practice Guide For Furniture And Television Tip-over Prevention



- Put the TV on the platform, fix one end of the tip-over prevention belt in the TV wall mounting hole with screw. Then fix the other end of the tip-over prevention belt on the platform or other suitable surface with screw. (Choose the suitable crews according to the TV size and model to fix the screw in the TV wall mount hole).
- The wall anchor should be fixed 0n the wall or other surface permanently, screw fixed in the wall must be put into the
 rubber plug to avoid breaking the TV and cause server personal injury. (figure 2).
 Attention: Check whether the tip-over prevention belt is fixed firmly after installation to avoid accident occurring.
 The screws fixed in the platform or wall are included in the accessory bag.


Quick installation manual

Tipping prevention materials

- 1. Please disconnect all the cable connections before installation.
- 2. Lay the TV face down on a flat surface, on a blanket or towel to avoid damaging the screen.
- 3. Please keep the TV in a horizontal position and fix the standing base with screws.




• Only use matching screws provided by manufacturer in the accessory bag to install the stand of TV unit, in order to avoid damaging the TV unit.



Wall Mounting Instruction:

This TV is equipped with mounting holes of 400 x 400mm. If the thickness of the wall mount is 2mm, 4PCS of type M6x10mm screws are required (the length of the screws fixed in the interior of the TV should not be longer than 12mm) Recommend to use SONIQ wall mount and install by professional people (do not operate while the TV is on).






CONTROL BUTTON

Note:

The following is only functional schematic, And the actual position and arrangement of different models may be different. Some models has 5 buttons, some models has 7 buttons.



In the standby state, press the STANDBY button to turn on the TV; in the startup state, short press the STANDBY button to turn off.

To adjust the volume, press the VOL +-key, and to change the channel, press the CH +- key. To open the setup menu, please press the MENU button, SOURCE to switch the signal source.

TERMINAL

The LED TV has many multimedia functions. It can be connected to many types of equipment. The following paragraph shows how to connect to other Audio and Video devices.

REAR AV Connections (SIDE)


All the terminals are (from left to right): HDMI4(ARC), ANT IN, USBTF, EARPHONE, YPbPr Input.

REAR AV Connections

USBAll the terminals are (from left to right):

RJ45, OPTICAL output, AUDIO input(L/R), VIDEO, HDMI1, HDMI2., HDMI3.

Note: VIDEO and YPbPr share one audio channel. When HDMI port get DVI signal, the audio signal receives from the AV Audio channel.



REMOTE CONTROLLER

The remote controller cannot be used unless it is within the receivable range. Before you use the remote control, please make sure there's no obstacle between the remote control and the receiver.



- Open the battery cover and insert 2 "AAA" batteries.
- Point the remote control at the remote sensor located on the unit.
- When there is a strong ambient light source,
 the performance of the infrared remote sensor may be degraded, causing unreliable operation.
- The recommended effective distance for remote is about 16 feet (5 meters).
- When the batteries become weak and the operating distance of the remote control is greatly reduced, you will need to replace the batteries.
- If the remote control is not going to be used for a long period of time, remove the batteries to avoid damage caused by battery leakage or corrosion.
- Do not mix old and new batteries or ALKALINE or standard (CARBON-ZINC) or rechargeable (NICKEL-CADMIUM) batteries.
- Always remove batteries as soon as they become weak.
- Weak batteries can leak and severely damage the remote control.
- Do not dispose of batteries in fire, they may explode or leak.
- Batteries should not be exposed to excessive heat such as sunshine, fire or the like.







CHANNEL

- Cable Set the signal type to cable. When set to Cable, the TV can receive analog and QAM broadcasting signals


- 1.Press the "**RED**" and "**BLUE**" buttons at the bottom of the remote control for 5 seconds.
- 2.When the LED starts to flash, release it. The remote controller will send the pairing signal to the TV and display the information of the remote control on the right side of the screen.
- 3.Press the **OK** button to display the pairing. If the paired is displayed, the connection is successful.
- 4.If the couldn't pair appears, the connection fails.
 Wait 30 seconds and then press the "RED" and
 "BLUE" buttons at the bottom of the remote control
 for 5 seconds to repeat the previous steps.
- 5.Press EXIT or BACK button return to the previous menu.

ADD AND USE OF MULTI MEDIA PLAYER





1. In the HOME interface, select the + icon in the APP column to add the application, and click OK. Press up and down to select the MultiMediaPlayer application, and click OK to add it to the HOME interface.



2. Select OK key to enter Multi Media Player and display Video, Photo, Audio. After inserting the usb flash drive, you can view the corresponding files in the usb flash drive.

The menu/function may be different depending on when you purchased the TV.

Symptom	DEALING METHOD

Remote not responding	Check the effect of the batteries. If necessary, replace the batteries or clean the remote control sensor window. The distance between the set and the remote control should be less than 6 meters.
Abnormal Color	Check the antenna connection.
TV set needs to be cleaned	Please pull the plug out when cleaning the screen. Use a soft, clean cloth to wipe it off. If needed to clean further, please use dry cloth, do not use naphtha or other thinners liquids.
System Error (For Smart TV only)	 Retry current operation. Enter the home page, and select "Restore Factory Setting" in the menu of System Setting. Do not cut off power during restore period. Power off, then restart.
